Parental/Child Learning Opportunity

We have the chance to run a course in school if there is enough interest from our parents, carers and grandparents. We would hope to run the course after February half term. Please let us know if you would be interested in taking part by Friday, 19th January for us to confirm with the provider.

Join our Multiply Champion to go through some of the teaching methods used in school today to help you support your child. The first part of the session will look at the techniques used, and the final part will give you a chance to put this into practice and work with your child by answering some maths challenges. As well as helping you to better support your children you will also receive a £20 supermarket voucher if you attend the course.

Sessions would start at 2.30 for parents and the children will join at 3.30. They would be delivered as follows: 4 x 1.5-hour sessions - Hour 1: methods and strategies with parents, final 30 minutes parents working with children on a range of questions.


<u>PE in School</u>
