

# WOODLAND SCHOOL NEWSLETTER 15th September 2023





Welcome back to school! Here is some information about the term. The children have all enjoyed their first week back and they have settled into their new classes quickly.

#### **Equipment**

The children do not need any pencil cases or equipment other than a book bag or school bag.

#### <u>Sport</u>

Squirrel class will need a full PE kit on Tuesdays and Fridays.

Owl class will need a full PE kit on Wednesdays and Thursdays.

The children can bring their PE kit to school and leave it there if they wish. It will be sent home before each holiday (or when dirty). PE kits should contain blue or black PE shorts and a red t-shirt. The children will also need an outdoor kit of blue or black leggings or jogging bottoms, a blue or black hoodie or sweatshirt and outdoor trainers.

#### Music

If your child has music lessons with Mrs Unwin, they will need their instrument on a Tuesday morning. She will also be doing some whole class sessions with the Owls.

# Snacks and Drinks

Squirrel class will continue to have an afternoon snack provided by school. All children can bring a healthy snack from home if they wish e.g. a piece of fruit. Milk will be provided for all children under 5. Once the children are 5, you can continue to pay for milk. All children need to bring a full water bottle each day which can be refilled at school if necessary.

#### Homework

Owl class will receive a homework timetable detailing when homework will be given out and when it should be returned. Reading books should go home each evening and it is important all children, regardless of age, should be practising their reading at home and in school. Your child will also receive a sheet with some information regarding our mathematics KIRFS (Key Instant Recall Facts). These are facts which your child will be working on this term to encourage quick recall of maths facts. Please practise these at home with your child.

### Student Council

Next week we will vote for our Student Council representatives from Year 1-6. If your child is interested in being on the Student Council, they should prepare a short speech to present to the other children.

All new parents should have received an e-mail inviting you to join if you need any help setting it up just ask.

If you have any questions just let us know.


