Welcome back to school!

Below you will find some information about the new term. The children have all enjoyed their first full week back and they have settled into the new classes quickly.

Equipment

The children do not need any pencil cases or equipment other than a book or school bag.

Sport

Squirrel class will need to wear a full PE kit on Tuesday and Friday.

Owl class will need to wear a full PE kit on Thursdays and Fridays.

The children can bring their PE kit to school and leave it in school if they wish. It will be sent home before each holiday (or when dirty). PE kit should contain blue or black PE shorts and a red t-shirt. The children will also need an outdoor kit of blue or black leggings or jogging bottoms, a blue hoodie or sweatshirt and outdoor trainers.


Music

Year 3 and 4 will be having Music lessons with Mrs Unwin once every two weeks beginning Friday 19th of September. If you child has a recorder at home, they can bring it for those sessions however school has recorders for children to borrow.

Snacks and Drinks

All children can bring a healthy snack from home if they wish e.g., pieces of fruit or vegetables. No chocolate products or crisps. Milk will be provided for all children under 5. Once the children are 5, you can continue to pay for milk if you wish. Each day, all children need to bring a bottle filled with water which can be refilled at school when necessary. Squirrel class will continue to have an afternoon snack provided by school.





Homework

Owl class will receive a homework timetable detailing when homework will be given out and when it should be returned. All children will bring a reading book home each evening and it is important all children regardless of age should be practising their reading at home and in school.

Student Council

Next week we will vote for our Student Council representatives from Year 1 -6. If your child is interested in being on the Student Council, they should prepare a short speech to present to the other children by Wednesday 17th of September.

<u>Administering Medicines</u>

New guidelines specify that we will no longer be able to administer Calpol or Anti-histamines unless in an emergency or it has been prescribed for your children from the doctor. If your child has any medication in school, it must be prescribed by a doctor, in its original packaging, with a pharmacy label showing your child's name and dosage required. Any child with asthma, now requires an Individual Healthcare Plan. These will be sent home this week and if you need any help filling them in, please let us know. If your child is asthmatic, please ask your GP for an asthmatic plan.

Intimate Care

All parents of children in EYFS now need to read and sign the Intimate Care Guidance. This allows staff to change your child if they have any toileting accidents. Where possible, we encourage the children to be independent but we do need to them support at times.

Meet the Teachers

On Wednesday 17th of September between 3.30-5pm we will hold a drop-in session for Parents in Owl and Squirrel class where you can ask any questions about the year ahead and meet the teacher.

We will also hold a phonics information session at 3.30pm and 4.30pm in Squirrel class. We look forward to seeing you. If you have any questions just let us know.


Advanced Notice Pantomime Visit


